Respect

Throughout, students have shown respect for themselves and other people. When engaging with online learning students have actively "listened" to others with an open mind, shown consideration for others, used positive and appropriate language, and followed teacher instructions. They have represented the school in a positive way.

Accountability

Students have set personal goals and had high expectations of themselves to improve. Their ability to maintain a positive attitude and enthusiasm for learning over the last few weeks has been impressive. They have used their initiative to react to the new experience of remote learning and have taken responsibility for completing work, on time.

Persistence

Our students have persisted when challenged with issues encountered through remote online learning and used initiative to resolve IT issues, in a calm and constructive manner. Students attempted tasks to the best of their ability and sought alternative ways to solve problems.
