

Dear parents/carers

The State Government committed to providing students with access to a device to support remote and flexible learning in Term 2.

To facilitate this, schools were invited to complete a survey to assist the Department in identifying their individual student device needs. Based on the survey response from Casterton Secondary College, the school received a small number of Internet Access Devices.

To support your son/daughter with remote flexible learning the school is providing an Alcatel 3T10 tablet device to be used in conjunction with a provided SIM card to simulate a hotspot internet connection.

The attached Department of Education and Training Equipment Loan Agreement provides the terms and conditions for use. The school's Acceptable Use Agreement Policy and Privacy Policy can be found on the CSC Website: www.casterton.vic.edu.au

The school expects your child to:

- Engage with online learning
- Communicate with their teachers as requested.
- Submit all work on time.
- Use the device to access education related sites only.

If this does not occur you will be asked to return the device to the school (the Equipment Loan Agreement states: the school can request the return of the device at any time).

If the internet connection is poor we will ask that the device be returned to the school so that it can be distributed elsewhere.

If you experience technical issues with the device please contact the school.
